What's new in Source2VALUE™ 5.0?

For **developers** and those responsible for improving the maintainability of the software, clone (duplicated code) detection has been revised. Finding and analyzing duplicated code has become much faster. Source2VALUE™ detects code that has been duplicated exactly or syntactically.

For **test engineers** Source2VALUE™ 5.0 can now export Quicktest Pro page definitions (forms, entities, fields, buttons, etc.) for selected technologies. This saves time and money spent creating and maintaining regression test sets. Test engineers also benefit from the Health Check that provides easy insight into the changed components and their complexity.

Source2VALUE™ has a new, fast and easy to use graphical user interface. Flashplayer is no longer required for accessing the Source2VALUE™ 5.0 portals, which are now browser independent.

Project managers and team leaders can now create **custom reports** using the export facility. All information from the Source2VALUE™ portal can be exported to MS/Excel.

With Source2VALUE™ 5.0 it is much easier to answer the questions that were never asked before. All information is now stored in a data warehouse that is easy adaptable and extensible for specific needs.

Last but not least, a tablet application with the overall quality and productivity reports will support **mobile insight for management**.
